## 2024 Ohio State Cup North Format U9-U19

## THREE TEAM DIVISIONS -U9B Super Group, U14G Super Group, U15G Super Group

Each team plays 2 games in Preliminary group play. $1^{\text {st }}$ place team advances to the Semi-finals. $2^{\text {nd }}$ place team plays $3^{\text {rd }}$ place team to determine the $2^{\text {nd }}$ team to advance.

FOUR TEAM DIVISIONS - U16B Super Group, U11G Super Group, U12G Super Group
Each team plays 3 games in Preliminary group play. Top 2 teams advance to semi-final.
FIVE TEAM DIVISIONS - U11B Super Group, U12B Super Group, U17B Super Group, U9G Super Group
Each team will play the other teams in its Group for a total of four (4) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams will advance to the semi-finals.
FIVE TEAM DIVISIONS- U13B Super Group, U9G Premier, U17G Super Group
Each team will play the other teams in its Group for a total of four (4) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams will advance to FINALS.

## SIX TEAM DIVISIONS - U14B Super Group, U15B Super Group, U10G Super Group, U13G Super Group U16G Super Group, U19G Super Group

Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) teams each. They will play a cross-over format. i.e., A1 will play $B 1, B 2$ and B3, etc. The top 2 teams will advance to the semi-finals.

## EIGHT TEAM DIVISIONS - U17G Premier

Will consist of two (2) Groups of four (4) teams each. Each team will play the other teams in its Group (round robin within their group of 4 teams) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. The top 1 team in each group will advance to the semi-finals.

## NINE TEAM DIVISIONS - U10B Super Group

Will consist of a group 5 and a group of 4 . The group of $5 \& 4$ will play a round robin format with teams from their own bracket. The top two in each bracket will play an additional match. A1 will play B2 and A2 will play B1. The winners will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.

## NINE TEAM DIVISIONS - U16G Premier, U19G Premier

Will consist of one group of 9 teams. Each team will play 2 games in the preliminary round. After those games are played, we will re-seed. Seed \#8 and \#9 will play a consolation game. $1^{\text {st }}$ Place - will receive a "bye", $2 v 7,3 v 6,4 v 5$. $1^{\text {st }}$ place plays the winner of $4 v 5$. The winner of $2 v 7$ plays the winner of $3 v 6$. The winner of these matches will advance to the semi-finals.

## TEN TEAM DIVISIONS - U9B Premier

Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) and one group of four (4). Each team in bracket B and C will play a crossover, teams in bracket $A$ will play a round robin with their four (4) team division. The $1^{\text {st }}$ place of $A$ plays the $2^{\text {nd }}$ place of $B / C$. The $2^{\text {nd }}$ place of $A$ plays the $1^{\text {st }}$ place of $B / C$. The winner of these matches will advance to the FINALS.

## ELEVEN TEAM DIVISIONS - U18/19B Super Group, U13G Premier, U15G Premier

Division of Eleven (11) Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) and one group of five (5). Teams in Bracket B will play teams in Bracket C, teams in bracket A will play a round robin within their five (5) team Bracket $A$. The $1^{\text {st }}$ place of A plays the $2^{\text {nd }}$ place of $B / C$. The $2^{\text {nd }}$ place of A plays the $1^{\text {st }}$ place of $B / C$. These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.

## TWELVE TEAM DIVISION - U18/19B Premier, U11G Premier

This group will consist of 3 groups of 4 . Each team will play in a round robin format. The team with the most points in each group will advance. The wildcard will go to the next team regardless of group with the most points. A v Wildcard, B vs C. The winners will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.

## THIRTEEN TEAM DIVISION - U13B Premier, U14B Premier, U15B Premier, U14G Premier

Division of thirteen (13) Will consist of two (2) groups of four (4) and one group of five (5). Each team in Bracket B and C will play the other teams in its Group (round robin within their group of 4 teams) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. Teams in bracket A will play a round robin within their five (5) team Bracket for a total of (4) preliminary round games. Top 2 teams in bracket A and the top team from Bracket $B$ and $C$ will play an additional match. $A 1$ will play $C 1$ and $A 2$ will play $B 1$. The winners will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.

## FOURTEEN TEAM DIVISION - 12G Premier,

Will consist of two (2) Groups of four (4) teams each and two (2) Groups of three (3) teams each. In the groups of 4 each team will play the other teams in its Group (round robin within their group of 4 teams) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. The top team in each group of 4 will advance to a qualifying match. In the groups of (3) teams, they will play a cross-over format. i.e., C1 will play D1, C2 and D2, etc. The top two point holders of C and D combined will play an additional match. First of A will play the $2^{\text {nd }}$ of $C / D$. and the First of $B$ will Play the First of $C / D$ The winners will advance to the semifinals.

## SIXTEEN TEAM DIVISION -U10G Premier

Will consist of FOUR (4) Groups of four (4) teams each. Each team will play the other teams in its Group (round robin within their group of 4 teams) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. The top team in each group will play A1vD1, B1vC1. The winner of these matches will advance to the semi-finals.

## SIXTEEN TEAM DIVISION - U16B Premier, U17B Premier, U10G Premier

Will consist of FOUR (4) Groups of four (4) teams each. Each team will play the other teams in its Group (round robin within their group of 4 teams) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. The top team in each group will play A1vD1, B1vC1.The winner of these matches will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.

## EIGHTEEN TEAM DIVISION - U10B Premier, U11B Premier

Will consist of two (2) groups of five (5) and two (2) groups of four (4). In the group of five (5) each team will play the other teams in its Group for a total of four (4) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams will advance to a qualifying game. In the groups of four (4) each team plays 3 games in Preliminary group play. Top 2 teams advance to a qualifying game The qualifying games are as follows: Game \#1 is A1 vs D2. Game \#2 is B1 vs C2. Game \#3 is C1 vs B2. Game \#4 is D1 vs A2. The winner of Game \#1 will play winner of Game \#2. The winner of Game \#3 will play winner of Game \#4. Winners of these games will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.

## NINETEEN TEAM DIVISION - U12B Premier

Will consist of 3 groups of 5 and one group of 4. In the group of five (5) each team will play the other teams in its Group for a total of four (4) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams will advance to a qualifying game. In the groups of four (4) each team plays 3 games in Preliminary group play. Top 2 teams advance to a qualifying game. The qualifying games are as follows: Game \#1 is A1 vs D2. Game \#2 is B1 vs C2. Game \#3 is C1 vs B2. Game \#4 is D1 vs A2. The winner of Game \#1 will play winner of Game \#2. The winner of Game \#3 will play winner of Game \#4. Winners of these games will advance to the semi-finals These qualifying games must be played by May 15th.
