

2024 Ohio State Cup South Format U9-U19

THREE TEAM DIVISIONS – U11G Premier, U15B Super Group, U17B Super Group

Each team plays 2 games in Preliminary group play. 1st place team advances to the Semi-finals. 2nd place team plays 3rd place team to determine the 2nd team to advance.

FOUR TEAM DIVISIONS – U9B, U14B, U16B, U19B, U9G, U14G, U19G Super Groups

Each team plays 3 games in Preliminary group play. Top 2 teams advance to semi-final.

FIVE TEAM DIVISIONS – U11G Super Group, U11B Premier, U17G Premier, U18/19G Premier

Each team will play the other teams in its Group for a total of four (4) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams will advance to the semi-finals.

FIVE TEAM DIVISIONS – U10B

Each team will play the other teams in its Group for a total of four (4) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams will advance to the super group semi-finals and the next 2 teams advance to the premier semi-finals.

SIX TEAM DIVISIONS – U13B Premier

Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) teams each. They will play a **cross-over format**. i.e., A1 will play B1, B2 and B3, etc. The top 2 teams will advance to the semi-finals.

SIX TEAM DIVISIONS – U10G, U12G

Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) teams each. They will play a **cross-over format**. i.e., A1 will play B1, B2 and B3, etc. The top 2 teams based on points advance to the super group semifinals. The 3rd and 4th place teams based on points advance to the premier group semi-finals.

SEVEN TEAM DIVISIONS – U12B Super Group, U14G Premier

Will consist of one group of 7 teams. Each team will play 2 games in the preliminary round. After those games are played, we will re-seed. 1st Place –will receive a “bye”, 2v7, 3v6, 4v5. 1st place plays the winner of 4v5. The winner of 2v7 plays the winner of 3vs 6. The winner of these matches will advance to the semi- finals. These qualifying games must be self-scheduled and are to be played between May 7th and May 14th.

EIGHT TEAM DIVISIONS – U12B Premier, U14B Premier, U11B Super Group

Will consist of two (2) Groups of four (4) teams each. Each team will play the other teams in its Group (**round robin within their group of 4 teams**) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. The top 1 team in each group will advance to the semi-finals.

EIGHT TEAM DIVISIONS –U16G

Will consist of two (2) Groups of four (4) teams each. Each team will play the other teams in its Group (**round robin within their group of 4 teams**) for a total of three (3) preliminary round games. The top 2 teams in each group will advance to qualifying games. Top of A will play second of B and second of A will play top of B in a qualifying game. The winner of these matches will advance to the Super Group semi-finals. The finalists will advance to the Premier Semi-finals. These qualifying games must be self-scheduled and are to be played between May 7th and May 14th.

NINE TEAM DIVISIONS – U13G

Will consist of a group of 5 and a group of 4. The group of 5 & 4 will play a round robin format with teams from their own bracket. The top two in each bracket will play an additional match. A1 will play B2 and A2 will play B1. The winners will advance to the semi-finals. The winner of these matches will advance to the Super Group semi-finals. The finalists will advance to the Premier Semi-finals. These qualifying games must be self-scheduled and are to be played between May 7th and May 14th.

TEN TEAM DIVISIONS- U15B Premier, U16B Premier, U17B Premier

Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) and one group of four (4). Each team in bracket B and C will play a crossover, teams in bracket A will play a round robin with their four (4) team division. The 1st place of A plays the 2nd place of B/C. The 2nd place of A plays the 1st place of B/C. The winner of these matches will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be self-scheduled and are to be played between May 7th and May 14th.

TEN TEAM DIVISIONS- U15G

Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) and one group of four (4). Each team in bracket B and C will play a crossover, teams in bracket A will play a round robin with their four (4) team division. The 1st place of A plays the 2nd place of B/C. The 2nd place of A plays the 1st place of B/C. The winner of these matches will advance to the Super Group semi-finals. The finalists will advance to the Premier Semi-finals. These qualifying games must be self-scheduled and are to be played between May 7th and May 14th.

ELEVEN TEAM DIVISION – U18/19B Premier

Division of Eleven (11) Will consist of two (2) groups of three (3) and one group of five (5). Teams in Bracket B will play teams in Bracket C, teams in bracket A will play a round robin within their five (5) team Bracket A. The 1st place of A plays the 2nd place of B/C. The 2nd place of A plays the 1st place of B/C. The winner of these matches will advance to the semi-finals. These qualifying games must be self-scheduled and are to be played between May 7th and May 14th.
